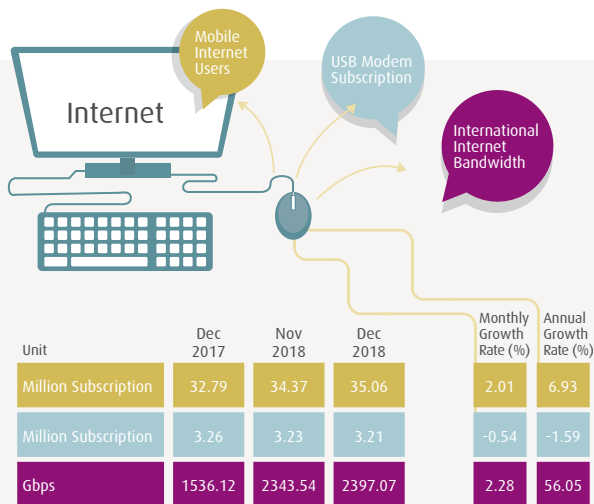

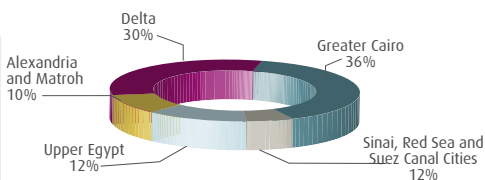

### ADSL Subscriptions Regional Distribution

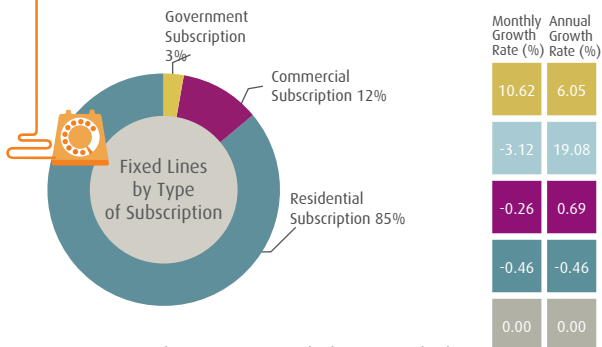

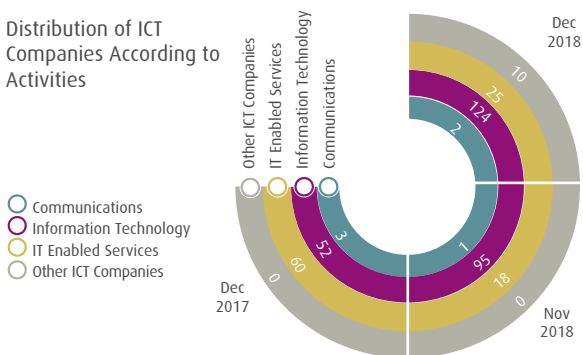

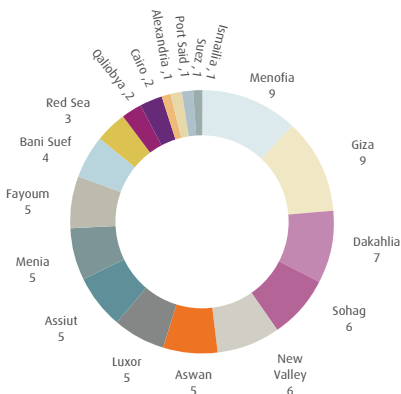
